SUNNYVALE POSTAL & PUBLIC SAFETY COMPLIANCE

MASTER SPECIFICATION: USPS-STD-4C & SUNNYVALE DPS STANDARDS

1. THE 1:5 PARCEL MANDATE

Standard: A minimum of one integrated parcel locker is required for every five mail compartments (USPS-STD-4C).

SV Context: Moffett Park tech campuses, Mathilda Avenue corporate facilities, and mixed-use developments along Historic Murphy Avenue must satisfy this ratio to clear delivery certification at Mary Avenue.

2. SUNNYVALE DPS ACCESS SPECS

Standard: The Sunnyvale Department of Public Safety (Sunnyvale DPS) mandates certified master-key override hardware and key-vault access for all secure commercial and residential lobbies.

SV Compliance: Certificate of occupancy requires public safety bureau validation. We integrate compliant key switches and physical override hardware per Sunnyvale DPS Fire Prevention regulations.

3. ADA & TITLE 24 HEIGHTS

Standard: Lowest shelf at 28" min (parcel lockers at 15" min); highest tenant lock at 67" max above finished floor.

SV Compliance: The Sunnyvale Building Division enforces California Title 24 clear egress path minimums. Recessed assemblies are mandatory within primary transit corridors to eliminate protrusion hazards.

4. HIGH-END SEISMIC ANCHOR

Standard: Pedestal (CBU) cluster boxes mandate 3500 PSI reinforced concrete foundation pads with 5-inch minimum structural anchoring.

SV Context: Cherry Chase communities, Lakewood Village clusters, and Peery Park office complexes require engineered base plates and AAMA 2605 architectural fluoropolymer powder coatings to resist South Bay conditions.

Sunnyvale's status as a critical Silicon Valley technology and research core requires tamper-proof, high-throughput delivery management infrastructure. Reed Brothers Security installs compatible mailboxes, with concrete anchoring, to ensure uninterrupted Day 1 delivery.

MARY AVENUE POST OFFICE RED-TAG ADVISORY

Failure to coordinate route inspections and master arrow lock provisioning with the Sunnyvale Postmaster at Mary Avenue 14 days prior to project sign-off is the leading cause of delivery red-tags. We manage appropriate USPS lock assignment and perform a pre-inspection technical audit so your residents have mail access on Day 1.
